- Applications for credit / account facilities must be made in writing to the Accounts Department.
- Where credit facilities have not been arranged or accepted, by Belfast City Airport Limited, payment terms are cash or credit card before aircraft departure.
- The PRM charge (Persons with Reduced Mobility) is set each year.
- Fuel infrastructure fee included into-aircraft element.
- In the event of the diversion of a passenger flight into Belfast City Airport or a General Aviation Flight, the Passenger Load Supplement and Security Levy shall be applied to the arriving passengers and not the departing passengers.
